

## **Procedure for using a Network Drive**

1. Create a Folder on Windows that you want to save video clips to. For example if you have a F: driver, you can create a Video\clips directory. Right-click the mouse to display a menu similar to the image below:



2. Select the "Sharing and Security..." menu option. You should see a dialog like the following:



- 3. Do the following:
  - a. Select the "Share this folder on the network" field.
  - b. Select the "Allow network users to change my files" field.
  - c. Enter a "Share name:" that only contains letters and numbers, but does not contain any spaces. For example, "MyClips" is a valid name.
  - d. Click the "Apply" button.
- 4. Point your browser to "File -> Remote Dir". The following should display:



- 5. Do the following:
  - a. Enter the PC's IP Address in the "Server IP Address" field.
  - b. Enter the share name from step 3.c in the "Share name (Windows)" field.
  - c. Click the "Yes" button in the "Use Directory" field.
  - d. Click the "Update" button.
- 6. You should see something like the following:
